## Case documentation – Information sheet

The Swiss Observatory of Asylum and Foreign Nationals Law (SBAA) is an organisation independent of the state that campaigns for the rights of refugees and migrants.

### Why are we interested in your experiences?

Refugees and migrants go through various procedures in Switzerland (asylum procedures, family reunification, etc.) which are often complicated and not always fair. We are interested in the experiences that migrants and refugees have made in the course of these procedures. We collect their reports, compile case documentation and publish them. We inform politicians, journalists and experts and draw their attention to existing problems in legal decisions. In this way, together we can improve the situation for migrants and refugees in Switzerland.

### What do you need to know and do?



#### Your case will be documented and published anonymously.

- For your protection, name and age will be changed.
- Address and place of residence will not be published.



#### In order to document your experiences, we need as many documents as possible.

- None of these documents will be disclosed to anyone.



#### By signing the enclosed consent form, you agree that...

- ...your legal representation will send us all documents that concern your case.
- ...we can publish your report without mentioning your name or place of residence.



#### Only if you and your legal representation agree, we will be able to write down and publish your experiences.



We are not a counselling centre and we are not lawyers. For counselling, you have to contact your legal representation.
